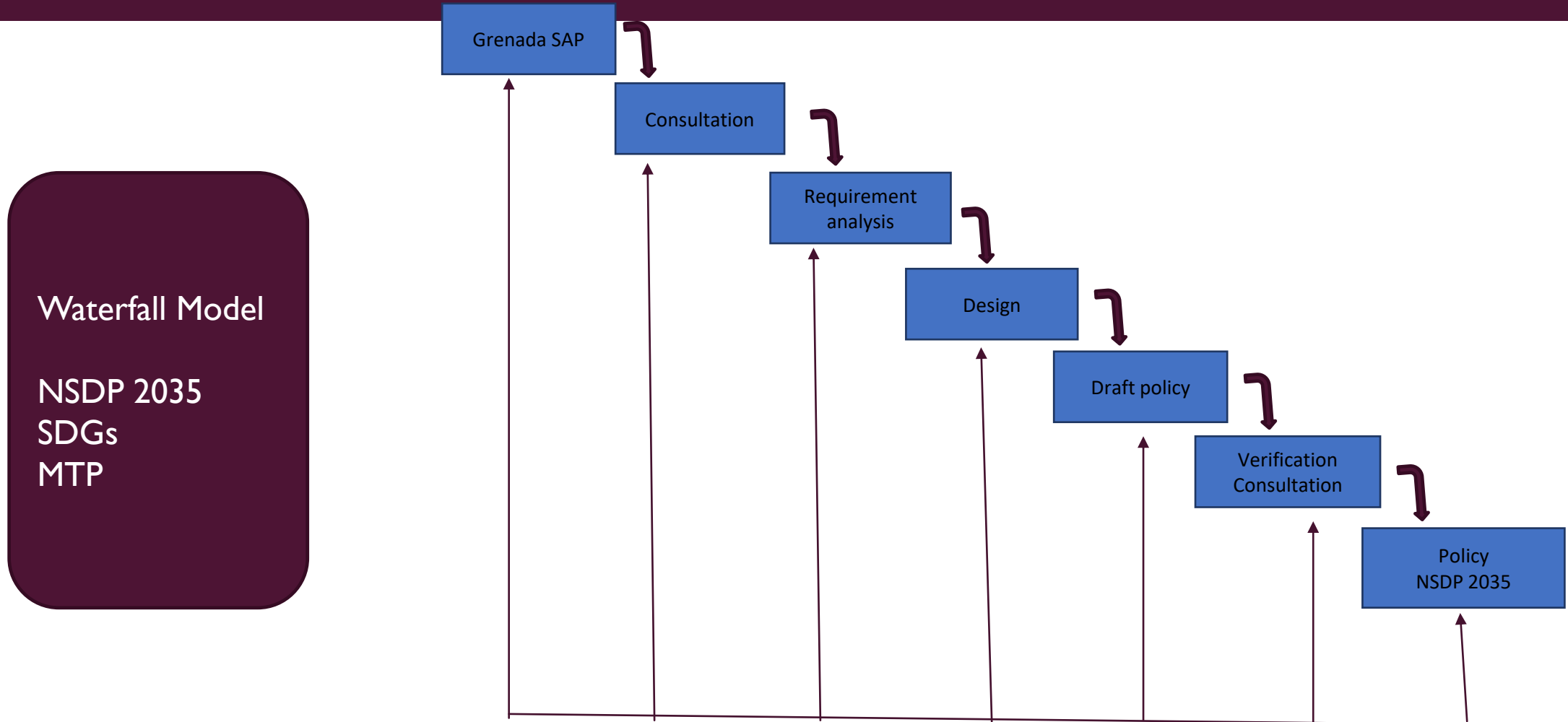

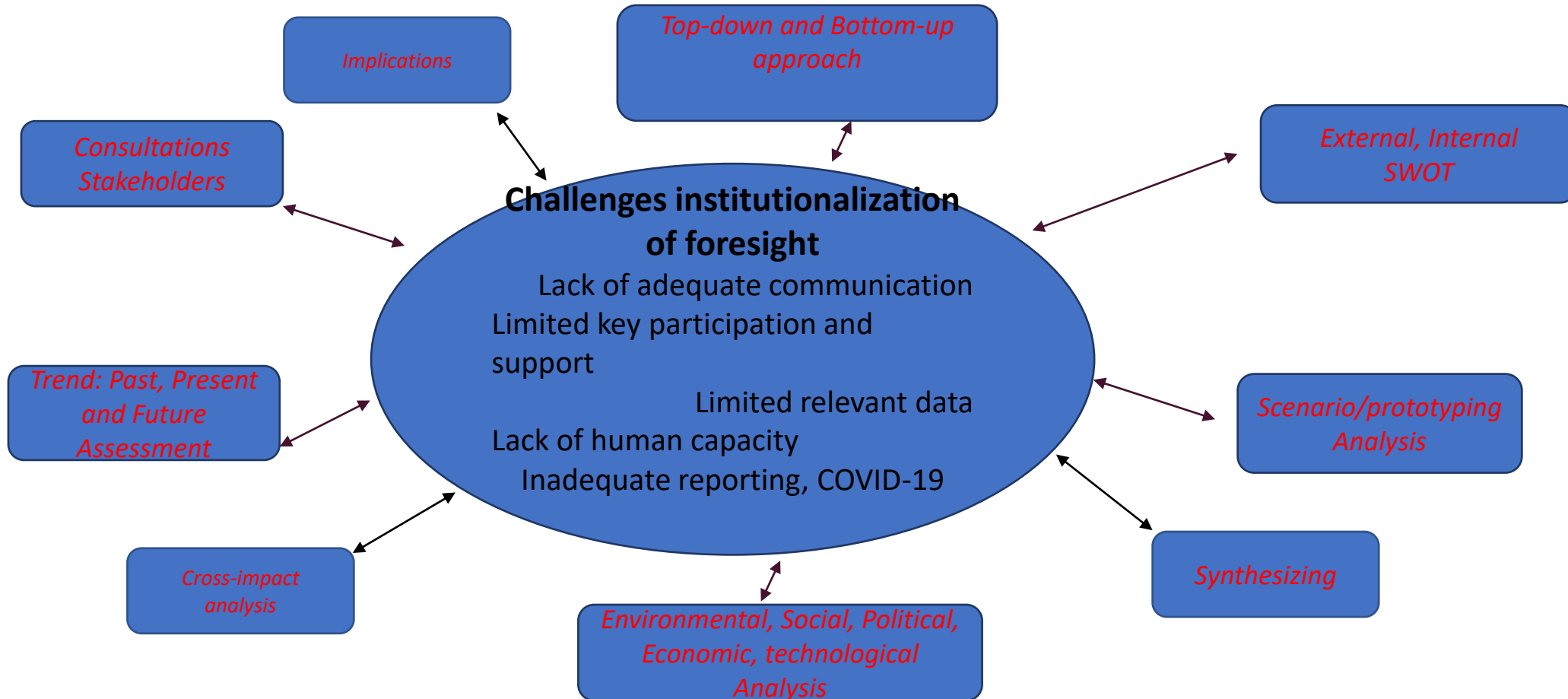

COVID- 19 CHALLENGES	MITIGATIONS
Movement of experts (International and regional Consultants)	Reduce travel restrictions
Face to Face engagement to Virtual consultations	Reduce travel restrictions
Implementation monitoring and evaluation restriction	Increase visual and more frequent reporting
Resources mobilization limitations and Access to Finance	Aggressively solicit grant and concessionary financing
GDP reduction and price increase	Seek to Ramp-up collection and apply price ceiling
Supply and demand impacts	Encourage innovation and subsidies
Operations streamlining – Limits implementation	Fully reopen the country
